RE: THE YAKIMA VALLEY FAIR AND RODEO IS NOW ACCEPTING VENDOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2009 EVENT!

Summary of Important Dates:

July 17, 2009 (Friday) – Due date for vendor application and deposit to be received by the YVFR.

August 5, 2009, 9 AM (Wednesday) – Start date and time for early vendor set up.

August 6, 2009, 12 PM noon (Thursday) – Date and time for vendor set up to be completed.

August 5th through August 8th, 2009 (Wednesday through Saturday) – Dates for the YVFR event.

August 9, 2009 (Sunday) – Vendor tear down, YVFR event closed all day.

The Yakima Valley Fair & Rodeo (YVFR) will be held again this year at Country Park in Grandview, WA. This will be our 82nd Annual Fair and our 9th Annual Rodeo! The fair will be held Wednesday August 5 through Saturday August 8, 2009, and this year it is going to be better than ever!!! You will want to plan on setting up your exhibit or booth for the entire time of the fair because of all the GREAT events that are going to take place.

In addition to the 4-H livestock shows, exhibits, and other events, there will be a number of fun contests taking place during the fair, and this includes the Friday evening "Diaper Derby". On Thursday there will be a big draw to the fair grounds due to the Band and Cheer Day that will be held again this year in preparation for the Grandview Parade that will take place Thursday evening. The Grandview Parade has grown to over 100 entries and attracts spectators from all over the Yakima Valley.

Our extremely popular rodeo event will be held on Friday (August 7th) and Saturday (August 8th) in the evenings. Our rodeo was part of the Pro West Rodeo Association since 2001, and in 2003 it was moved up to the big leagues and was placed in the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) circuit. Our rodeo event for this year will also be under the PRCA. We are also going to have the Grandview Chamber Car Show from 8 AM to 3 PM on Saturday again this year. The car show usually brings in over 100 vehicle entries and also brings in lots of additional fair spectators!

The Yakima Valley Fair and Rodeo will be held at the Country Park fair grounds, just off Interstate 82, at the Stover Road Exit 73 in the Yakima Valley at 812 Wallace Way in Grandview, Washington, 98930. The grounds include a 20 acre fenced facility with open grass areas, outdoor amphitheater, fenced horse arena, covered animal barns, enclosed 4-H and Horticulture buildings, baseball diamonds, sales arena, a large pavilion for dining, and lots of room for outdoor vendor tents!

Commercial booth and food vendor applications will be processed on a first-come first-served basis, so send in the enclosed Application/Contract and a check for your deposit as soon as possible! The required deposit is equal to the total amount of the fees associated with the vendor ordered space and/or tent rentals as shown in the "Booth Options" section of the Application/Contract. The total amount of any balance due by the vendor to the YVFR with regard to any other fees is payable at the time of vendor arrival at the fair. The commercial booth and food vendor area was very successful last year, and our available space each year is limited, so please send in your application early! In order for your application to be considered for acceptance, it must be received by 5:00 PM on Friday, July 17, 2009.

The commercial exhibit and food vendor booth options and prices are listed in the enclosed Application/Contract. Please sign and return the Application/ Contract, along with your check or money-order for the deposit, in order to have your application reviewed. Deposits will ONLY be returned when an Application/Contract is NOT accepted by the YVFR.

After receiving your completed Application/Contract and deposit payment, your Application/ Contract and attachments will be reviewed and considered for acceptance. The decision to accept or reject applications will be at the sole discretion of the YVFR. All applications will be processed on a "first-come first-served" basis with much weight given to those applications that arrive early and that are correctly completed, that include a payment for the correct deposit amount, that include complete descriptions of the services provided and/or the items to be sold, and that include photos or drawings of the vendor's booth or exhibit. You will be notified in writing as to whether or not your application has been accepted.

FOOD VENDORS, PLEASE NOTE: In order to be eligible for approval, applications from food vendors must include a certificate of insurance for one million dollars of liability insurance with the YVFR listed as an additional insured. In addition, food vendors need to note the following with regard to obtaining a temporary food permit:

For information about obtaining a temporary food permit from the Yakima Health District, see the following web site: <http://www.co.yakima.wa.us/health/eh/fstemp.htm>. A temporary food service permit is required for food service at one-time events or celebrations that are open to the public. These permits are good for up to 21 consecutive days at the same location and for the same event. If you have any questions about the Temporary Food Service Application, please call the Yakima Health District at 509-575-4040 or 1-800-535-5016. As of January 1st, 2008, all applications must be turned into the Yakima Health District at least two weeks before the event. A \$50.00 late fee will be charged for applications received within one calendar week of the event. Applications received within two (2) business days of the event will be denied. The permit is required whether or not payment is received for the food served. The 2009 cost is \$54.00.

Please also note that for the rodeo event we are encouraging the food vendors to provide the capability to transport food and beverages from their stationary locations in the food court to the rodeo arena area so that concessions can be sold to the rodeo patrons.

Acceptance confirmation letters will be mailed out to notify those vendors that have sent in applications that are accepted by the YVFR. Deposits will NOT be returned once the YVFR has accepted your Application/Contract. Because we do not want the same items being sold by a multiple of vendors, we reserve the right to limit the number of booths and exhibits that are similar in appearance, and to limit the number of similar products that are sold. Please remember that the commercial exhibit and booth set up time at the fair begins at 9 AM on Wednesday (Aug. 5) and must be completed by 12 PM noon on Thursday (Aug. 6). A season pass is required to get into the fairgrounds to set up your commercial exhibit or food booth on Thursday, August 6th.

The YVFR fair event will be open 8:00 AM to 11:00 PM on Wednesday and Thursday, and from 8:00 AM to midnight on Friday and Saturday. It is estimated that about 4,000 people attend the YVFR event during the four days that the fair is in operation.
